

Student Drawing Account Information Sheet

Each student has a Student Drawing Account (SDA). This account is maintained through the Business Office. Parents will be made aware of the SDA balance through statements e-mailed each month. A \$150 security deposit will be held until your child leaves. Your child may draw from the account as long as there are sufficient funds, not below \$150. Grades and comments or transcripts to colleges will not be mailed for any student with a negative SDA balance at the end of the school year. Any remaining funds in the SDA account will not be disbursed until all expenses have been received and paid in full. The anticipated release date of any remaining funds will be July 15, 2021. If a student is returning for the subsequent academic year, funds can remain in the account for use during the next academic year.
